

## SAFETY COVER INSTALLATION GUIDELINES

Congratulations on your purchase of a new Pool Craft safety cover. With this purchase we at Pool Craft can ensure you with a premium quality product along with a professional installation. However, there are some potential issues that may occur during the installation of the cover that cannot be anticipated or prevented. It is important that all customers who have purchased a safety cover are aware of these potential issues prior to installation.

Upon installation of your safety cover, some damage to the area around the anchors may occur. This damage can appear in a number of different ways and range from small chipping or cracks in your deck. Although these potential cracks are unpredictable, these cracks are cosmetic, not structural cracks and unfortunately there is nothing we can do to repair the damaged concrete. Concrete poured at a later date cannot be matched to the existing concrete and is very unsightly.

Pool Craft uses specialty equipment to minimize damages during installation and every precaution is taken to prevent chipping and/or cracking. In the event some chipping and debris occurs around the anchors, Pool Craft will make their best effort to ensure it is repaired to the best of our ability. Due to the nature of concrete, Pool Craft will not guarantee that the surrounding concrete will not chip. In the event the perimeter of the hole does chip, brass anchor collars (escutcheons) are available at an additional cost. These anchors are approximately 1.5" in diameter and in some cases not large enough to cover the damage.

Lastly, if your safety cover needs to be secured to a retaining wall, waterfall, diving rock or any other unique item adjacent to the pool; shifting or movement is unpredictable and repairs to these items or re installation of the safety cover will be at an additional cost. Repairs or re-leveling to specialty decking such as flagstone, interlock, wood etc. is not included in the original quote and can be priced separately upon request.
